



Block Size: $6\frac{1}{2}$ " ($8\frac{1}{2}$ ", $10\frac{1}{2}$ ")

Finished Size 6" (8", 10")

Fabric: Your choice of 3 contrasting fabrics

Block Construction:

Cut 2 – $3\frac{1}{2}$ " ($4\frac{1}{2}$ ", $5\frac{1}{2}$ ") squares from Fabric #1

Cut 2 – 2" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ", 3") strips (Fabrics #2 and #3)

Sew 2 – 2" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ", 3") strips together (Fabrics #2 and #3)

Cut into 2" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ", 3") units.

Cut a 2" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ", 3") strip from Fabric #3

Cut into 2" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ", 3") pieces

Assembly:

Make a square by sewing the strip to the 2 small square unit

Sew the pieced square to the whole square in the direction shown in the diagram

Repeat this procedure and sew the 2 halves together to make the block
